


# Changing Your Password

At some point, you may wish to change your user password. This section will instruct you on how to do so.

**WARNING:** You must remember your current password in order to change to a new one. As a security precaution, there is no recovery mechanism for forgotten passwords; if you are unable to recall your user created password, contact technical support at [www.smart-restart.com](http://www.smart-restart.com) for assistance.

To change your password, click the **"Change Password"** button on the SMART RESTART interface. You may view the actual characters in all fields by checking the box next to **"Display Password Fields."**

- 1) Type your existing password in the box next to **"Enter old password."**
- 2) Type your new password in the text box next to **"Enter new password"** and retype it in the box next to **"Verify new password."**
- 3) Uncheck the **"Display Password Fields"** box and click **"Submit Change."**
